The Astrology of Space

Today, she shares a few tips on the ideal office space with *Society*

How important is astrology for offices? What do you mainly concentrate on in an office space?

Since the office is a place which generates revenue for a lot of people, the right alignment of factors is important. Just like a factory deals with production, financial matters are dealt with in offices. Hence, the inclusion of small factors such as plants and change of surrounding colours can make a difference. Plants, colours, water fountains in the right direction and the right corner can balance energies.

Are there any other factors that should be taken care of?

Make sure that the main decision maker's chair in his/her cabin faces north or east. The chair should be against the wall and if not then compensate it with putting a high back chair that acts like a wall. Further, the accounts section should have a lot of red around it as red



is a colour of activity and it will add energy into the money generating area. Also make sure that the entry area is free of any hurdles whatsoever. In some places, there are doors banging into a stool or a plant that should not be there. The door should be simple so that nobody is afraid of stepping into the office. The people going in and out of the office should have clear space in front of them. Also, the reception area should have the company's name behind the front office executives' desk. For places where employees don't seem to stick around, try putting a drooping money plant because that can ensure a person's settling down.

Other than these, while consultation, what is the first thing that you focus on?

In 'astro-architecture', it is very important that the area on which the office stands is in the company's name and not in the individual's. This is important since the energies which change after my consultation will affect the company as a whole and not just one person. If the office space is under rent, try to get an agreement of some sort done so that the firm's name is involved.

How aware are owners in terms of using sciences such as Vaastu and Feng Shui for their offices?

The trend of *Vaastu Shastra* and other similar sciences are growing. Since an office is a generator of income for so many people, the importance for it to be perfect is even more. Nowadays, people consult me with problems such as the rising percentage of attrition of staff in the office. 'Astro-architecture' can help in such situations. <<
